The Gnomes had to figure out how to get the animals out at night because



they stand in a line bumping each other. So they build a special Garage DOOR that raises and lowers. One gnome raises the door and lowers the door as a secret-type animals walks out and "sits

on the Platform" then, after the door closes, the animal "huffs & puffs," and they



grow 10 to 20 times their normal size. A gnome jumps on their back, and off they go "FLYING down" to the ground. After they hit the ground, they disappear way into the dirt under the grassroots.

It's just like on TOP, roads made by worms crawling through the ground. One

gnome goes East, and one gnome goes South West.

They look at their Compass that directs them. All Gnomes carry a COMPASS to know which way to go. This is their Special Taco Bell Compass. It has a clip so they wouldn't lose it in the Worm Tunnels. Which side of the Tree points to the North?

The huge worms, known as "night crawlers,"



make the paths under the ground. That is until they hit a STONE or a BIG rock. That is when the "night crawlers" have to change direction because their bodies can't move the ROCKS. Once the Rocks are busted up by the gnomes, the Fairies continue to make the HOLES straight as they can be. Little worms follow the path making the path permanent.

The Fairies all work during the day, clearing BUGS off the property.

Ants are a problem. Then make deeper holes in the ground and never use WORM Holes. In fact, if they come across a worm, they will all attack it and chase it away. The worm will head for the surface because ants can't stand the sun too long. They get confused and go in all directions.
